


Richard Lieder, a member of the River City Corvettes since about 1973, passed away on Thursday, February 26, 2004 and will be greatly missed.

Richard E. "Dick" Lieder, 56, of La Crosse died Thursday, Feb. 26, 2004, at Lakeview Healthcare Center in West Salem, Wis., where he had been a resident since June 2000.

He was born on Sept. 25, 1947, in Cedar Falls, Iowa, to Harold and Alice (Hayek) Lieder and graduated from La Crosse Central High School in 1966. He also attended UW-L until he was drafted into the U.S. Army, where he served in Korea during the Vietnam War.

On April 30, 1977, Dick married Renee Grapes in La Crescent, Minn. Until the time of his injury in May 1998 he had owned and operated Leader Tree Service in La Crosse. He was an active member of the River City Corvette Club and loved fixing and restoring Corvettes. He also was active in the La Crosse Beekeepers Association and was an avid gardener. Dick was an outdoorsman who made a living fishing and trapping and also enjoyed hunting.

In addition to his wife, Renee, Dick is survived by his three children, Elizabeth, Anna and Robert, all of La Crosse; two grandchildren, James Butterfield and Joseph Lieder, also of La Crosse; one sister, Susan (Herman) Givant of Des Moines, Iowa; one brother, David (Cheri) Lieder of Waukesha, Wis.; his mother-in-law, Dolly Grapes of La Crosse; aunts and uncles, Verlyn Lieder, Willard Tronick, John and Lois Hayek, George and Jean Hayek.

He was preceded in death by parents; a sister, Linda Johnson; and an infant brother, Eric.

A memorial service will be held Sunday, Feb. 29, at 12:30 p.m. at Our Savior's Lutheran Church, with the Rev. Rachel Thorson-Mithleman officiating. A memorial gathering will be at the church Sunday from noon until the time of services. Burial will take place at
