- **Personal Information:**

Include your name, address, contact information, and relevant details

- **Academic Record:**

Submit transcripts (if applicable) showing your academic performance, GPA, and coursework related to automotive technology or engineering.

- **Essay:**

Address specific prompts or questions related to your career aspirations, your interest in the automotive industry, and your plans after graduation.

- **Letters of Recommendation:**

Provided by teachers, counselors, or industry professionals who know you well to write letters supporting your application.

- **Career Goals:**

List short-term and long-term career goals within the automotive industry, mechanic, engineer, or auto body specialist.

- **Financial Need:**

Money needed for tuition, tools, etc; illustrating financial requirements.

- **Extracurricular Activities:**

Highlight any relevant extracurricular activities or projects that demonstrate involvement in the automotive industry or related fields.

Tips for applicants:

- **Start Early:** Give yourself ample time to gather all the necessary documents and complete the application thoroughly.

- **Tailor your Essay:** Address the specific requirements of each scholarship application.

- **Seek Feedback:** Have someone review your application before submitting it.

- **Follow Instructions:** Adhere to all deadlines and submission requirements.
